Terms and conditions for the sale of Various Vehicles through auction

1. The Tender document can be availed at Maharashtra Gramin Bank Head Office, (cost of Tender document is Rs.100/-)
2. No bid shall be accepted after the scheduled date and time. The sealed cover should be super scribed "AUCTION OF VEHICLES FOR SALE OF OLD USABLE BANK'S CARS" with full name, contact number and postal address of the Bidder. The bids without sealed cover/envelop will be rejected.
3. The last date of submission of the bids in sealed envelope is 09.03.2026 up-to 05:00 pm. The bids must be dropped in the tender box kept at following address and same will be opened on 10.03.2026 at 03:00 pm in the presence of participating bidders Asst. General Manager, .

4. A bidder must be/ have a person/registered firm with valid GST / Pan, Card, Valid Aadhar/Address proof, etc. .
5. The bidder can bid one or more than one vehicle and H-1 "successful bidder will be decided per vehicle.
6. The conditional bid shall not be entertained. .
7. The vehicles will be sold on "As is where is whatever there is basis" and no guarantee or certificate of its worthiness or quality will be given by our department. No requests for inspection of vehicle other than as mention above (specified day Et time) will be entertained.
8. The bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit as per above mention by the way of Demand Draft/ Pay Order issued by a scheduled commercial bank in favor of "Maharashtra Gramin Bank" payable at Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidder shall be returned subsequent to the award of contact to the successful bidder. No claim lies against Maharashtra Gramin Bank in respect of erosion in the value or interest on the amount of EMD) (i.e. EMD will be interest free). The bid without EMD will be summarily rejected.
9. The successful bidder after acceptance of his/her bid will be required to deposit the accepted bid amount within 7 (Seven) working days from the date of issue of work order/ Intent letter from Maharashtra Gramin Bank. The final sale amount (after adjusting of EMD amount) is to be deposited in the form of DD/PO/RTGS/NEFT, failing which the earnest money(EMD) will be forfeited.
10. The auctioned items are to be lifted from the site within a specified date from the issue of release order or such period as may be decided by the authority on an "as is where is and whatever there is basis".
11. Any e - challan levied by the government will be borne by the bidders.
12. If the H1 price is quoted equally by more than two bidders, an auction will be conducted for that particular vehicle among those H1 bidders. The vehicle will be allotted to the bidder who places the highest bid in the auction. However, to participate in such an auction, an additional 10 % EMD must be deposited through Demand Draft before Participating in the auction.
13. The buyer will be responsible for safety and security of the auctioned items after delivery of items to the successful bidder. Maharashtra Gramin Bank, will not be responsible for any damage/pilferage of the auctioned items.
14. Before lifting the vehicles by the successful bidder, necessary documents will be provided by the Bank.
15. The delivery of the sold vehicles will be given only to the successful/ H-1 bidder after submission of documentary evidence in support of residential status (Ration Card/ Voter Identity Card/Aadhar Card, etc.) in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms.
16. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred at his own cost expeditiously. The Bank will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard. Bank will not be liable for any mishap/ accident, etc. after delivery of vehicle/s to the successful bidder.
17. The sold vehicle/ s shall have to be removed by successful bidder at his own expenses from the office premises.

18. If, the Buyer fails to make the requisite payment within the time/extended time stipulated, the sale relating to old cars can be cancelled at the discretion of the Bank/ Seller/Auctioneer and the EMD deposited by the Bidder shall be forfeited in full and the Seller/ Auctioneer shall be entitled to recover any incidental/consequential loss suffered by it as a result of such failure. The Seller/Auctioneer shall not be bound to give any notice to the buyer for the said forfeiture.
19. Maharashtra Gramin Bank reserves the right to accept/reject the offers or cancel the whole Auction proceeding without assigning any reason whatsoever.
20. Maharashtra Gramin Bank shall not be responsible for delayed submission or non-submission of bid due to any reason whatsoever.
